JuanCarlos M. Hunt serves as the Director of the Office of Civil Rights, where he provides leadership, direction, and guidance in carrying out the Agency's equal employment programs, which includes compliance with Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) laws and regulations. Prior to joining EPA, Mr. Hunt was an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) at the Social Security Administration (SSA), where he adjudicated disability benefits cases. Before becoming an ALJ, Mr. Hunt served as the Director of the Office for Civil Rights and Diversity at the U.S. Agency for International Development and at the U.S. Department of Justice (Department), Executive Office for Immigration Review (EOIR).

Prior to that Mr. Hunt held several positions within EOIR's Office of the General Counsel, including Deputy General Counsel and Acting General Counsel. Mr. Hunt has also worked as an Attorney-Advisor at the Department's Office of Justice Programs, Office for Civil Rights, where he ensured that law enforcement agencies complied with federal anti-discrimination laws, and as a Trial Attorney at the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission, where he enforced federal anti-discrimination laws.

Mr. Hunt's experiences also include working an Associate at a multinational law firm and as a Federal Judicial Law Clerk in the U.S. District Court, Middle District of Pennsylvania. Mr. Hunt is a graduate of Cornell University and Case Western Reserve University, School of Law. He is a native of New York City, is married, has two sons, and enjoys sports, musicals, and traveling.
